Objective (s)	 Children to delve into a specific literary work and/or author and present them to others.
Age level (s)	• 6-12
Preferable number of participants	• 15 - 30

Setting, materials, and preparation	Place: Art room, Computer lab, classroom, or library
Step -by-step description	 Children choose a phrase or stanza from a literary work they have read and liked. They make a picture frame, which they then decorate. Using calligraphy or other aesthetically attractive and innovative methods, they present the phrase or stanza within the picture frame, also providing the title of the text and the author's name. The frames are displayed in the classroom, the library, or other places in the school.
Notes to reading promotion facilitator	 ICT may be used during this activity, as there is a wide range of software that may be used to create the frames and images/texts.
Suggested follow-up actions/ activities	 An illustration from the book or the author's photo may also be included in the frame.
