Duration	2 - 3 hours
Setting, materials, and preparation	<p>Setting: Library or classroom</p> <p>Materials needed: PCs, pencils, notebooks</p> <p>Preparation:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. A short interesting or funny story to be told to the audience 2. Tips about how to write and tell someone's own story
Step-by-step description	<p>Welcome and present the aims of the meeting.</p> <p>Tell introductory short story (it would be better to invite an author or storyteller to coordinate the entire activity).</p> <p>Explain tips and important issues for storytellers.</p> <p>Children discuss with their parents or grandparents their own stories.</p> <p>The child and his/her parent or grandparent write down the text of their story on the computer and prepare the presentation of the story.</p>



	<p>All the stories are told. The texts of the stories are printed and the copies are given to all the participants. The teacher/librarian or the author/ storyteller comments and coordinates a concluding discussion.</p>
Suggested follow-up actions/ activities	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Participants may vote for the best story.• The participants of the meeting can perform their stories.• Children and parents can search the Internet the images or photos, which can become illustrations to their stories.• PowerPoint presentations with the stories can be made, using images and music.
